Ask questions: make connections to the child's life throughout the story. Re-read the same books over and over to help your child learn new words.

Track the words with your finger so they see where you are reading.

Fabulous 5 of Learning to Read for Preschoolers

Clap out words into parts (ba-na-na). Learn letter names and their sounds. Expand vocabulary by introducing a wide variety of new words (tired = exhausted).

Attempt to write, even if it's scribbling. Retell events and stories in an order that makes sense.
